Junge Triennale and Globus Comprehensive School in Duisburg are organising a theme week from 31 January to 4 February 2022

Bochum, 01.02.2022 – At the moment in Duisburg, tight moves are being invented, theatre is being created on a computer stage and the class book is being converted into a drum computer! As part of the #nofear project, the Junge Triennale is working with more than 100 pupils from the **Gesamtschule Globus at Dellplatz in Duisburg** on their theme week "Performing & Designing". Up **until 4 February**, young people in grade 6 will try out nine artistic-creative workshops using film, dance, theatre, music, rap, drawing and writing, guided by a wide range of artists.

As part of the Ruhrtriennale, the Junge Triennale inspires young people and children to enjoy culture in a broad range of events. With the theme week, the Junge Triennale continues its long-standing collaboration with both the Globus Comprehensive School and the Duisburg-Hochfeld district. The theme week is organised by the Junge Triennale as part of the #nofear project, funded by the Mercator Foundation.
