### Tickets available again!

**Bochum, 10.09.2021** – The Ruhrtriennale is increasing its seating capacity in response to the new NRW Coronavirus Protection Ordinance. This is particularly pleasing for events that have already been sold out for a long time in advance, as more tickets can once again be offered.

These include productions in the Jahrhunderthalle Bochum, such as the "**Visionary Architects**" **concert** of the Bochum Symphony Orchestra under the baton of the new general music director Tung-Chieh Chuang next Saturday, 28 August. Tickets are also available again for the **production "Die Toten"** by Ruhrtriennale artistic director and director Barbara Frey from 1 September, as well as for the **concert "Elias"** by Chorwerk Ruhr on 9 and 10 September and the **production "Los Años / Die Jahre"** by director Mariano Pensotti from 17 September.

As before, seats will be offered on a chessboard basis. In addition, masks are still compulsory as a matter of principle, both inside the venues and during seating, and the 3-G rule applies.

Until 25 September, the Ruhrtriennale presents 37 productions and projects at nine venues in the cities of Bochum, Essen, Duisburg and Gladbeck, including eleven in-house and co-productions. With eight world premieres, five German premieres and four adaptations from the programme of the Ruhrtriennale 2020, the internationally oriented six-week festival invites its audience to a variety of artistic experiences in a total of 117 events. More than 600 artists from around 30 countries are involved in this year's Ruhrtriennale.
