

A furious tour de force through the history of greed: The film installation "Euphoria" by Julian Rosefeldt makes its worldwide debut at the Ruhrtriennale

**Bochum, August 26, 2022** – "Euphoria" is the new expansive multi-disciplinary film installation of video artist and filmmaker Julian Rosefeldt, who previously enthralled the Ruhrtriennale audience in 2016 with his work "Manifesto". The **world premiere of "Euphoria"** has been presented as part of the Ruhrtriennale 2022 on Thursday, August 25, at 6 pm in **Halle 5 of the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site Zollverein** in Essen. The film installation will now be open every day until Saturday, September 10, from noon to 7.30 pm.

The two-hour work, which will be shown in a loop, is a furious tour de force through the history of economic theory. The project consists of original texts from famous economists, writers, philosophers and poets, and traces the 2,000-year history of human greed. Actors, including Giancarlo Esposito and Virginia Newcomb appear in the movie as contemporary characters, while Cate Blanchett provides her voice for a talking and singing tiger. The music was composed by Canadian Samy Moussa. British composer Cassie Kinoshi has also contributed one chapter. The musical component of the project was created in cooperation with the Brooklyn Youth Chorus and five of the most renowned contemporary jazz percussionists of our time, who provide the driving force to "Euphoria." The language of the film installation is English with German subtitles.

In an interview with dramaturge Judith Gerstenberg, **Julian Rosefeldt** talks about his interest in the clash of contradictory voices in his most recent work. He says that in "Euphoria" "both the positions of the neoliberal market economy and of its critics unfold their power of seduction and persuasion." Rosefeldt also reports how his film team and he were forced to leave the City of Kyiv shortly before the war in Ukraine began. **"Euphoria"** is a Park Avenue Armory, New York, production, which was commissioned in partnership by the Ruhrtriennale, Holland Festival, Amsterdam and Rising Melbourne, in cooperation with World Cultural Heritage Site Völklinger Hütte.
